

BELVOIR HALF MARATHON

& 7km Road Race

7km Road Race starts 10.15 a.m.

The race starts at Hose Village Hall, which is on the road between Long Clawson & Harby, some 7 miles north of Melton Mowbray, 15 miles south—east of Nottingham and 16 miles to the west of Grantham. The National Grid Reference is SK738 292. Maps of the area and other information can be accessed on the website: www.hosevillage.org.uk/bhm.htm
Access to the hall is straightforward: it is the only building in Hose on the south of the Harby-Long Clawson road. Car-parking is available on the adjacent playing-field: access will be at the other end of the field from the hall.

- Entry by Post, On-line or On-the-Day
- Postal & On-line entries must be received by 22nd March so that Race Nos. can be posted
- Entry On-the-Day starts at 8.00 a.m.
- Number of runners limited to 700 book beforehand to ensure a place
- Entrants for the Half Marathon must be 17 or over; for the 7km Race they must be 15 or over

• Half Marathon Entry Prices are:

- ➤ £30 standard entry fee
- ➤ £28 discounted entry fee for licensed members of clubs
- ➤ £35 standard entry fee for 'On-the-Day' entry
- ➤ £33 discounted entry fee for 'On-the-Day' entry for licensed members of clubs
- 7km Road Race Entry Prices are:
 - > £10 for all runners
- On-the-day payment can be made by card or cash
- Free parking at Hose Village Hall
- Timing will use an RFID tag, giving an accurate personal time from start to finish
- DO NOT wear earphones, as these may compromise your safety on the course
- Pleasant rural course with few hills
- Good opportunities for personal best times
- First Aid support around the course
- Five water stations around the course
- Time & placing for all finishers, published on-line or sent by post
- Individual finish time sent to your mobile phone (give your number on Entry Form)
- Memento for each competitor as finish line is crossed
- Numerous trophies: individual, senior, veteran, super-vet, team for both sexes
- Team entries: a team can have any number of men or women
 - First four men to finish qualify for men's trophy
 - > first three women to finish qualify for women's trophy
- Trophies presented approximately 12.00 noon
- Refreshments & snacks available at Hose Village Hall from 9 a.m.
- Changing and showering facilities are limited
- There may be Pre- and post-race massage available
- Official photographs of runners may be available
