CLAWSON HOSE & HARBY PARISH COUNCIL PARISH PRECEPT 2011/12

In 2007, after public consultation, the precept was increased by £10k annually for three years (2008/2010) to provide funds for the three village halls. This sum represented an increase in your Council Tax of 12 pence per week based on a Band D property. It was agreed to reduce the precept to its original base after three years. There was no increase to the Precept for the current financial year 2010/2011. Additional inflationary costs were engrossed.

The Parish Council have unanimously agreed not to increase or decrease the Parish Precept portion of the Council Tax for the next financial year 2011/2012. It intends to use the £10k to fund upgrading the street lighting in the three villages, repair the wall surrounding the closed graveyard at Hose Church and provide a new bus shelter in Harby. The Parish Council is responsible for the maintenance of closed graveyards, including walls and fences. The Parish Council street lighting was recently surveyed by Leicestershire County Council and it is estimated that it will cost £13k to replace worn out or damaged equipment. A working party is investigating the capital cost of fitting part night photocells and low energy bulbs to reduce the electricity bill. There will be public consultation before any changes are made to the current street lighting arrangements.
